MEDIA ALERT

On December 19th, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District awarded \$471,360 to seven Sonoma County agencies and nonprofits through its newly established Climate Protection Grant program. The program's goal is to cut Bay Area carbon dioxide emissions by 350,000 tons within the next five years – equivalent to the amount generated by 70,000 cars driven everyday for a year.

The Accountable Development Coalition was awarded \$30,000 to fund its ongoing green building policy initiative. The grant will fund the advocacy of “best practice” green building policies in Sonoma County as well as efforts to promote similar policies on a regional level.

“On the heels of the Santa Rosa City Council’s vote to approve mandatory green building standards, we are thrilled to be taking our advocacy to the next level,” says Michael Allen, Chair of the Accountable Development Coalition. “The Accountable Development Coalition looks forward to pushing for stronger policies to protect the environment and provide healthy, comfortable places for our residents to live and work.”
